
# **About LoftZone**

# How can attic boarding help you?


There are three main reasons that people board their attic above the insulation

### More storage space

Are you fed up with mess? Do you never seem to have enough storage to keep your home tidy?

Well the attic is usually the largest under-used space in a home, so using LoftZone StoreFloor provides you with the valuable storage space that so many households would benefit from - space that you probably don't realize you have.

You can turn your attic into a fantastic area to keep storage boxes, which is strong enough to walk on and easy to access.







#### Safe access

Walking in insulated attics is dangerous; you can't see where to step and if you stand on the ceiling instead of a joist, it may not take your weight. Every year, thousands go to hospital because of falls from or through attics. So if you have anything in the attic that needs access, from boxes to aircon units to solar inverters, then you need to have a safe access platform.

Many maintenance engineers won't enter your attic unless you have a safe access platform for them. The good news is that LoftZone has been independently tested and shown to exceed the strength requirements for flooring in a house.

#### Reduce energy bills

Research by the National Physical Laboratory and Carbon Trust has shown that attic insulation is frequently compressed down to joist level on the floor of the attic, in order to provide storage space and/ or to allow for safe access walkways. TThis compression reduces the insulation's effectiveness by at least 50%, meaning higher heating and aircon bills.


With LoftZone StoreFloor you have a raised decking system above your attic floor, this allows a platform to be installed above the full depth of insulation in a attic, and solves the issue of having your insulation compressed.





# What size is StoreFloor?

#### **Cross-Beam**



Carries the load. Made from engineering-grade recycled plastic. 11" tall.



# Is StoreFloor suitable for your property?

LoftZone StoreFloor is suitable for almost all attics, new and old, including cut, purlin and truss-roofed types. It's frequently fitted in both houses and commercial buildings. Your joists will need to be made of wood and be at least 1.25" wide and 3" tall.

For our 48" metal Cross-Beams to fit, your joists should be either 16" or 24" apart on average (measured from the center of each joist to the center of the next one – not the distance in-between them). This covers the vast majority of US attics.

If your joists are a different spacing, then we recommend using the Cross-Beams that span 72".




# Installation

With LoftZone StoreFloor you have the option of fitting it yourself, or having it installed by professional installers. We are currently growing our list of installers in the USA. Or, we can help by providing advice to your own preferred tradesperson. The parts are lightweight and sized to easily fit through most attic hatches.

They are simply screwed to each other and into the joists. Attic boards to fit on top are a bit heavier, typically 11lbs each, but are still an easy DIY job. Our installation guide will walk you through the process, and to date thousands of people have chosen to do it this way.
